## HOW TO GROW CORREA

Perhaps no plant attracts more attention in the bushland of south-eastern Australian than a *Correa*. A single plant with only one or two pendant red bells displayed bravely during the winter months will attract the attention of the casual bushwalker just as readily as that of the earnest colour photographer. It has never been my intention to specialise in growing any particular genus of native plants, but for various reasons I have a large number of *Correas* in my garden. A check has just revealed 44 individual plants which include about ten different forms of "Common *Correa*" (*C. reflexa*).
